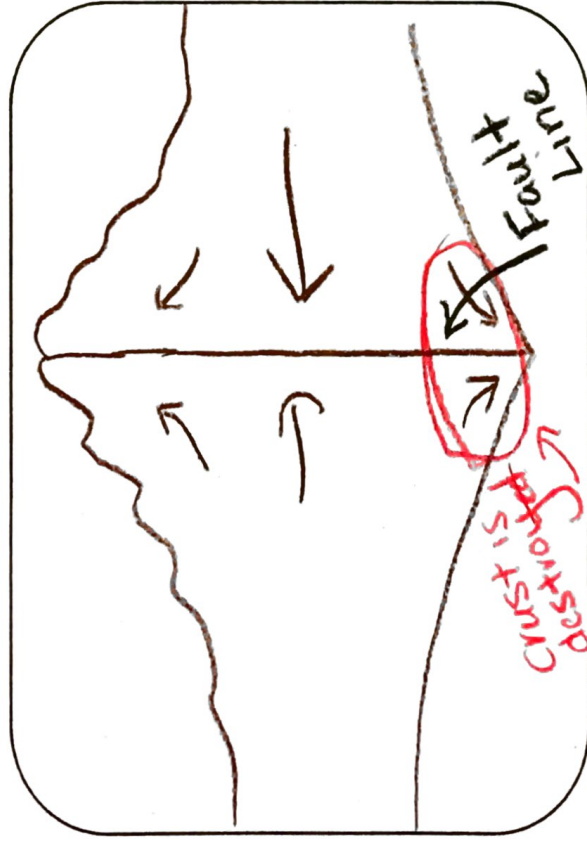


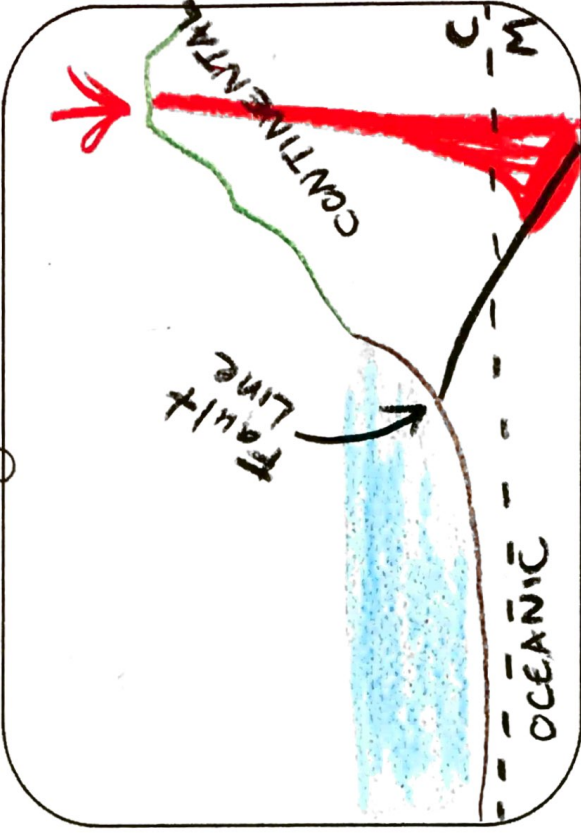
WORD: Convergent



DEFINITION: Plates converge or
move toward one another
 -destroys crust
 -make mountains, volcanic mtns,
 earthquake

EXAMPLES: _____

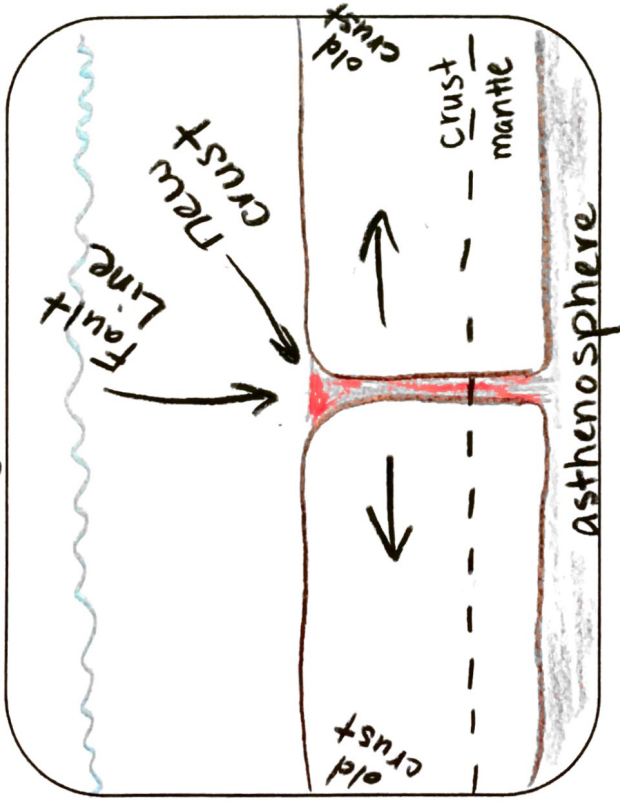
WORD: Convergent: Subduction



DEFINITION: When two plates collide,
the denser one goes beneath the
less dense one
 - volcanic mountains

EXAMPLES: Rocky Mountains
Mt. St. Helens

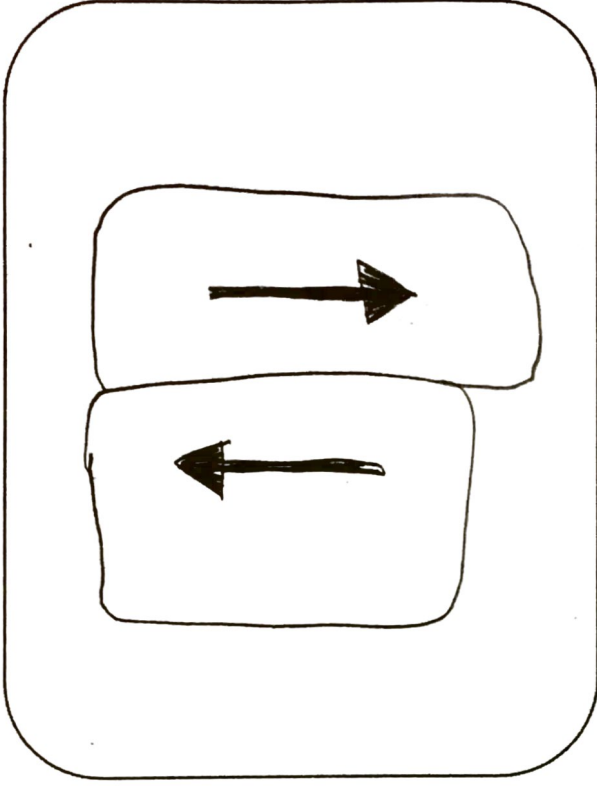
WORD: Divergent



DEFINITION: Plates move in opposite directions AWAY from each other
- creates new crust

EXAMPLES: HW:

WORD: Transform



DEFINITION: When plates slide past one another in opposite directions
- doesn't create or destroy crust

EXAMPLES: San Andreas fault, CA
